STIPULATED ORDER ON CREDITOR'S MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY

THIS MATTER comes before the Court on the stipulation of Debtor, the Trustee and JP MORGAN CHASE ("Creditor"), to resolve Creditor's Motion for Relief from stay. Debtor agrees that the confirmation of her Chapter 11 Plan annulled any bankruptcy stay that was in place.

THE COURT THEREFORE ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Creditor filed a Motion for Relief from Stay on June 9, 2008.
- 2. An objection was timely filed by the Debtor. No other objections were timely filed, and the deadline for objections expired July 7, 2008.
- 3. A preliminary hearing was held on the motion July 28, 2008. At the preliminary hearing the Debtor was represented by Charles Hughson, Creditor was represented by Karen Howden Weaver.
 - Debtor filed this bankruptcy proceeding January 19, 2005.
 - 5. Debtor's Chapter 11 Plan was confirmed on May 19, 2006.
- 6. Upon confirmation the automatic stay was replaced with an injunction as set forth in the Plan, the Order confirming the Plan and applicable law.
 - 7. The stipulation is well taken and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. The automatic stay terminated upon plan confirmation on May 19, 2006.
